Riesling trocken**

The 2013 Bechtheimer Geyersberg Riesling trocken from Weingut Spiess in Bechtheim/Rhein Hessen has a pale straw-yellow color. Very clear and precise on the nose where lime and ripe Riesling aromas are mixed with chalk flavors and hints of nuts. I has a piquant attack on the palate, excellent grip and is very dry with lots of citrus flavors that are firm and tightly woven. Very pure and straight on the edge, this very serious but still very young wine is not that well developed and needs time.

**2013 Spiess Bechtheimer Rosengarten
Riesling trocken**

The 2013 Bechtheimer Rosengarten Riesling trocken is straw yellow in color and offers a pure bouquet displaying ripe, dried and cooked apples, limes intermixed with lots of earthy flavors and wet limestones. Quite dense, juicy and piquant, this full-bodied, slightly sweet but well balanced wine finished with refreshing citrus aromas and leaves the impression of another excellent wine of this quite unknown Rhein Hessen family estate in Bechtheim.
